HRCH Property Wall Information:

The purpose of the wall is to set the boundary of our property line and to secure our materials inside the property. Costs will vary depending on design. A full concrete wall will cost approximately \$200,000 but a partial concrete and chain link style will cost approximately \$50,000.

At this point, 30 donors have given to the wall and \$38,845 has been raised. If you are interested in donating to the cost of the wall, you will need to make payment to First Lavaca and designate **HAITI WALL** in the memo line. A gift of \$500 or more can have a Memorial attached to it.
