# School is in Session

We are excited to let you know that the Hope Rising School started classes in September! The school serves the Leogane community as well as the HRCH children and currently offers classes for preschool aged children through 9th grade. The goal of the preschool program is to expose the children to English before they begin Kindergarten curriculum. The K-9th program utilizes the Abeka curriculum. The school also offers an afternoon English program. Right now, 81 students





attend the morning classes, and 33 students attend the afternoon English program.

Donations are still needed for supplies and furniture. We also need sponsors for children to attend. A \$60/month sponsorship will pay for their school, uniform, supplies,

# Hope for Haiti's Future Through the Children

We want to take this opportunity to introduce you to several more children under Hope Rising's care. We are still in need of \$40/month sponsors for these precious children. It takes several sponsorships for each child to meet all of their needs. If you haven't already committed to a child, please prayerfully consider doing so.



This is Carifana. She is the sister of Mykerson and Fritzson as well as cousin to Myline and Dieuphny. Her mom passed away over a year ago and she was living with her aunt when she passed away this January. Her oldest cousin tried his best to care for the 8 children that his mom was caring for but just couldn't support all of them any longer. She is such a beautiful girl inside and out with a splash of sassy.

In June, the UN and social services came to HRCH with this sweet baby She was found abandoned in a home. Hope Rising took her in on a temporary basis. Since then, the UN has placed her permanently with Hope Rising. She has been given the name Lily.

In August, four different government agencies came to Hope Rising with 7 boys, ages 2-8. It is very likely that they shut down an existing Haitian orphanage and these boys came from an extremely neglected and possibly abusive situation. They will be staying at Hope Rising until parents and family are located in the hopes of reunification. Until then, we are in need of temporary sponsors for these boys.

## MK Corner

<u>Hares for Haiti</u>....you might be wondering what in the world this is about. The Smithson kids have recently taken on a very interesting project. Hares for Haiti is a project developed through the ministry of Juniper Community Missions. The programs goal is to equip Haitians and other non-profit organizations to raise rabbits to supplement their food supply, and to sell them. Rabbits sell for \$10 (US), which is much more than a day's

pay for Haitians. Juniper Missions supply the training, which includes care, upkeep (including how





to build a cage), etc. and a male and female rabbit to get you started. You are required after the first set of babies to train someone else in your community/church to raise them as well...paying it forward. It's also required that you give back 5 babies after the first year to replenish JC Missions stock. Dean and Joel have embraced this endeavor. The Smithson's are expecting their first babies around Thanksgiving. The focus of this project is that families will be changed, communities will see a direct impact and neighbors will be reached for Christ. What an awesome ministry this is!
