Hope Rising To Host Marathon

Hope Rising will be taking the reins this year as host of the 20th Annual Midsouth Marathon and Half-Marathon held in Wynne, Arkansas, November 3, 2018. This time-honored event takes place in a slice of rural America, running between Crowley's Ridge and the farmland of the Mississippi River Delta. Every year runners from all 50 states and many different countries come to this small town of 8,000 to participate in the USATF certified course.



A few events have been added to this years' weekend. A 5K for all ages and toddler races for ages 1-5 will take place on Saturday morning. Registration and a runners expo will be all day on Friday, with the traditional pasta dinner on Friday evening.

A unique medal will be awarded to all runners who finish the course. Hope Rising has commissioned a Haitian artisan to produce the medals which feature a map of Haiti situated inside a map of Arkansas. Awards in each runner group will also be produced by the Haitian artisan.
