

A Family For Every Child

"A family for every child" is the new motto of child services in Haiti and has always been God's plan for children from the beginning. I love the Haitian Creole translation of Psalm 68:6: it is translated; "people who are without a family, God will give them a family." You may know the English translation as "God sets the solitary in families" and this is what God has been revealing to us since we started our orphan care ministry. We just didn't know how to make it happen or where to start until now. I would like to briefly share our new vision and plan for transition with you and encourage you to reach out to me personally with any questions. Our desire is to see each child that comes into our children's home end up with a permanent family. This could be reunification with biological family, integration into a foster family, or even with a national family wanting to adopt. Hope Rising Fellowship will play a huge role in finding quality families to care for kids. We have a thorough application process for the families as well as great training from the US that has been translated into Creole. We want to see the children stay in our community where they can continue being involved in everything Hope Rising has to offer: school, healthcare, sports, and church. We already have 2 success stories with biological reunification and are in the process of our first foster to adopt family. The transition will be a slow one and we would ask that you be praying for our staff and kids as we not only seek the Lord, but wait on Him to give direction concerning each specific child. Hope Rising Children's Home will continue to be a temporary safe haven for children needing to be rescued from neglect, abuse, or corrupt orphanages. Taking in children from situations like these is always very difficult. They will need time to heal before they can be placed into a family and our staff will need prayers daily to persevere with them. We realize this is all very different from what the original vision of Hope Rising Children's Home was 7 years ago, but we know that as Christians we have to be ready to change directions when God moves us and it is clear that this is what He wants for these children. We not only want to be obedient to God in this but obedient to the Haitian government's goals of "a family for every child".
