We are blessed to announce the newest ministry to the Hope Rising Campus. Welcome aboard Hope Rising Christian Clinic. Although there are some finishing cosmetic items to be addressed, the major construction was completed at the end of June.

July 15, 2019 was the official grand opening for the clinic. On this occasion, we received around 40 people in the reception room to welcome our newest ministry. We were pleased to accept 94 patients (customers) in our first 3 days. Since then, we have registered 620 customers and our staff has ministered to 360 patients. Our clinic laboratory opened the first week of September, and we expect many more patients. Our laboratory staff received a five-day extensive training on our equipment. Our goal like any other clinic laboratory is to provide our doctors with efficient data to diagnosis our patients. In addition, our location provides 3-4 surrounding communities an opportunity for medical care without major transportation fees, since we are within walking distance.

We are also very proud of the clinic staff. Each individual appears to be servant hearted and the camaraderie is evident in this group. Please continue to pray for this group. It's truly amazing to watch God work on the opening of this ministry. From construction to assembling the clinic staff, He has proved He is in control. We would like to thank each of you who donated and prayed with us for this clinic. We are excited to see what God has planned for the future.




MK Corner...Joel's view on school!

Otherwise, it's at the discretion of the customs worker to decide the items worth. We ask that you let us know that you have something coming, so we can be looking for it.

Please sure to write your child's name on the outside of the package.
